

RECREATIONAL TOWING REQUIREMENTS

DCT and/or Manual Transaxle Equipped FWD (2WD) Kia Vehicle Towing Requirements:

★ NOTICE

Confirm the maximum towing capacity of the recreational vehicle prior to towing your Kia.

Any Kia FWD(2WD) vehicle equipped with a DCT/manual transaxle may be towed with all four wheels on the ground behind another vehicle, such as a Recreational Vehicle (RV), as long as the following conditions are met:

1. DCT/Transaxle oil is at the recommended level
2. DCT/Transaxle is in correct working order
3. Parking brake is released
4. Gearshift is in **NEUTRAL**
5. Steering wheel is **UNLOCKED** with the key in the ignition and in the "ACC" position

★ NOTICE

When key is moved to the "ACC" position, make sure all accessories are turned off to prevent battery drain, and/or 12V back-up is provided to support battery power.

6. Front tires are of the same size
7. Tire pressures are equal and inflated to the recommended pressure
8. Vehicle is towed from the front with all four wheels on the ground

⚠ WARNING

Ensure ignition key is not turned to the "ON" position while towing. **In Side and Curtain Air Bag equipped vehicles**, the side and curtain air bag may inadvertently deploy when the ignition is "ON" and the rollover sensor detects the situation as a rollover.

When towing has been completed, be sure to turn key off, remove key from ignition and set parking brake and remove any 12V battery back-up support equipment. Do not leave key in ignition with vehicle unattended.

★ NOTICE

Emergency and/or disabled vehicle towing procedures are not provided in this bulletin; details are provided in the respective model's Owner's Manual.
